1. Conducting Student Feedback

As second and fourth semester exams are nearing, the student feedback using the newly designed forms is to be done now. The modalities of conduct may be decided by IQAC.

2. Preparation of AQAR 2018-19:

As per the norms of the NAAC, the Annual Quality Assurance Reports have to be submitted each year covering the period of June to June. The next AQAR is due by July 2019.

3. Proposal for promoting Inter disciplinarity

In recognition of the emerging view that knowledge is being generated in the interface of traditional disciplines. Universities world over are promoting inter-disciplinary studies, research and approaches. The draft master action plan already approved by the IQAC has also prioritized this. It is now proposed that enabling action in this regard be taken by the University as follows:

- 1. Every faculty member who is a research supervisor may consider accepting at least one student at any point of time in an interdisciplinary topic with joint supervisor from another department.
- 2. Every faculty member consider the possibility of seeking funding though collaborative proposals involving investigators from different departments.
- 3. Recognized departments to encourage PhD students to take up inter-disciplinary projects under supervision of teachers from different departments.
- 4. Every department consider organizing a seminar or other academic events in collaboration with a different Department.
- 5. Every department considers designing new certificate/diploma/masters or integrated masters programme involving different departments.
- 6. Every Department may organize inter-disciplinary talks, inviting experts from both allied and non-allied fields.

4. Waste Management: Proposal

Maintenance department presented the detailed waste management plan in the meeting. It is proposed to install dustbins in all the departments through a centralized purchase.

5. Proposal for new IQAC office and Boardroom

IQAC seeks an office with better space and facility of a board room with audio-visual facilities to accommodate 24 members. The space should be centrally located with due visibility and accessibility.
