The primary health center (PHC) is the basic structural and functional unit of the public health services in developing countries, to provide accessible, affordable, and available primary health care to people.. The main role of primary health care is to provide continuous and comprehensive care to the patients. It also helps in making the patient available with the various social welfare and public health services initiated by the concerned governing bodies and other organizations. Remote healthcare professionals face major challenges, including a critical shortage of specialized health workers, poor state of health facilities and equipment; add to it the high burden of epidemic disease such as HIV/AIDS, malaria and TB.. The Alma Ata conference has put forward eight important aspects of primary health care. They are: Health education, adequate of safe drinking water, nutrition, immunization, provision of essential drugs, availability and distribution of medicine, treatment of communicable diseases.
