## PROHIBITION OF RAGGING IN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS ACT 26 OF 1997:

Mamata Medical college in collaboration with District Legal Services Authority, Khammam organized awareness camp on Prohibition of Ragging act on 18july 2019 in Sri Puvvada Nageswarao Auditorium. The chief guest Sri Vinod ,senior advocate and Smt.Puvvadajayasree (Secretary MES) explained briefly about the act, salient features and punishments related to ragging in the educational institutes. Commits or a ragging shall be punishable as per Telangana Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1997 - ( Act 26 of 1997) ... Any student dismissed from a college for ragging should be debarred from seeking admission in any other course of study in college/University located in the state.

## PROHIBITION OF RAGGING

- Ragging is prohibited as per Act 26 of A.P. Legislative Assembly, 1997
- Ragging entails heavy fines and / or imprisonment.
- Ragging invokes suspension and dismissal from the College.
- Outsiders are prohibited from entering the hostels without permission.
- Girl students must be in their hostel rooms by 9.00pm.
- All the students must carry their Identity Cards and show them when demanded.
- The Principal and the Wardens will visit the hostels and inspect the rooms any time.
- Suspended students are debarred from entering the Campus except when required to attend enquiry and to submit an explanation.
