11. Caste Certificate of candidate and parent (for BC, SC & STs only) issued by Competent Authority.
12. Minority Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of Government. (for Muslim Minority)
13. Parental Latest Income Certificate (2023-24) issued by MRO/Tahsildar.
14. Migration Certificate (if applicable)
15. EWS Certificate for the year 2023-24 claiming reservation under EWS Categories issued by competent authority (Tahsildar) of State of Telangana (If applicable)
16. Equivalency Certificate issued by Board of Intermediate Education, T.S., Hyderabad (If passed qualifying exam other than Telangana State/A.P./CBSC/ICSE).
17. Passport Size photos (10)
18. Aadhar Card (Xerox) Student & Parent
19. Course Discontinuation Bond (Rs.20,00,000/-) ON NON-JUDICIAL STAMP PAPER FOR Rs. 100/-.
20. Residence Certificate (Candidates who have studied in the institutions outside of Telangana have to submit 10 years (years of period to be specified) residence certificate of the candidate or either of the parent issued by MRO / Tahsildar excluding period of study/employment)
21. Proforma for Undertaking in the form of Affidavit (on Non-Judicial) Rs.100/- Stamp paper by the Parent and candidate stating that the caste and area mentioned in the **certificates are genuine** and they will be held responsible for any further consequences as per law, if any discrepancy noticed. (WITH NOTARY).
22. Candidates claiming eligibility of reservation under Special categories i.e., CAP, NCC, PMC and Anglo Indian should furnish the required certificate in support of their claim.
